About the Seminar

Peter Ferdinand Drucker was born on 19th November 1909 in Vienna and was educated there and in England. He took his doctorate in public and international law while working as a newspaper reporter in Frankfurt, Germany. Drucker is a writer, teacher, and consultant specializing in strategy and policy for businesses and social sector organizations. He has consulted with many of the world's largest corporations as well as with non profit organizations, small and entrepreneurial companies, and with agencies of the U.S. government. He has also worked with free-world governments such as those of Canada, Japan, and Mexico. He is the author of thirty-one books which have been translated into more than twenty languages. Thirteen books deal with society, economics, and politics; fifteen deal with management.

Drucker's contribution to the field of management in the form of books, publications, research articles explored how humans are organized across the business, government, and nonprofit sectors of society. He is one of the best-known and most widely influential thinkers and writers on the subject of management theory and practice. His writings have predicted many of the major developments of the late twentieth century, including privatization and decentralization; the rise of Japan to economic world power; the decisive importance of marketing; and the emergence of the information society with its necessity of lifelong learning. In 1959, Drucker coined the term "knowledge worker" and later in his life considered knowledge worker productivity to be the next frontier of management.

To pay rich tributes to Peter Ferdinand Drucker, Department of Commerce and Management Studies, Dr.B.R.Ambedkar University, Srikakulam is going to organize a Management Seminar on "Management Principles of Peter F. Drucker and Its relevance in the Era of Globalization" on 19th November 2013.
